everything to find love he could rest in.

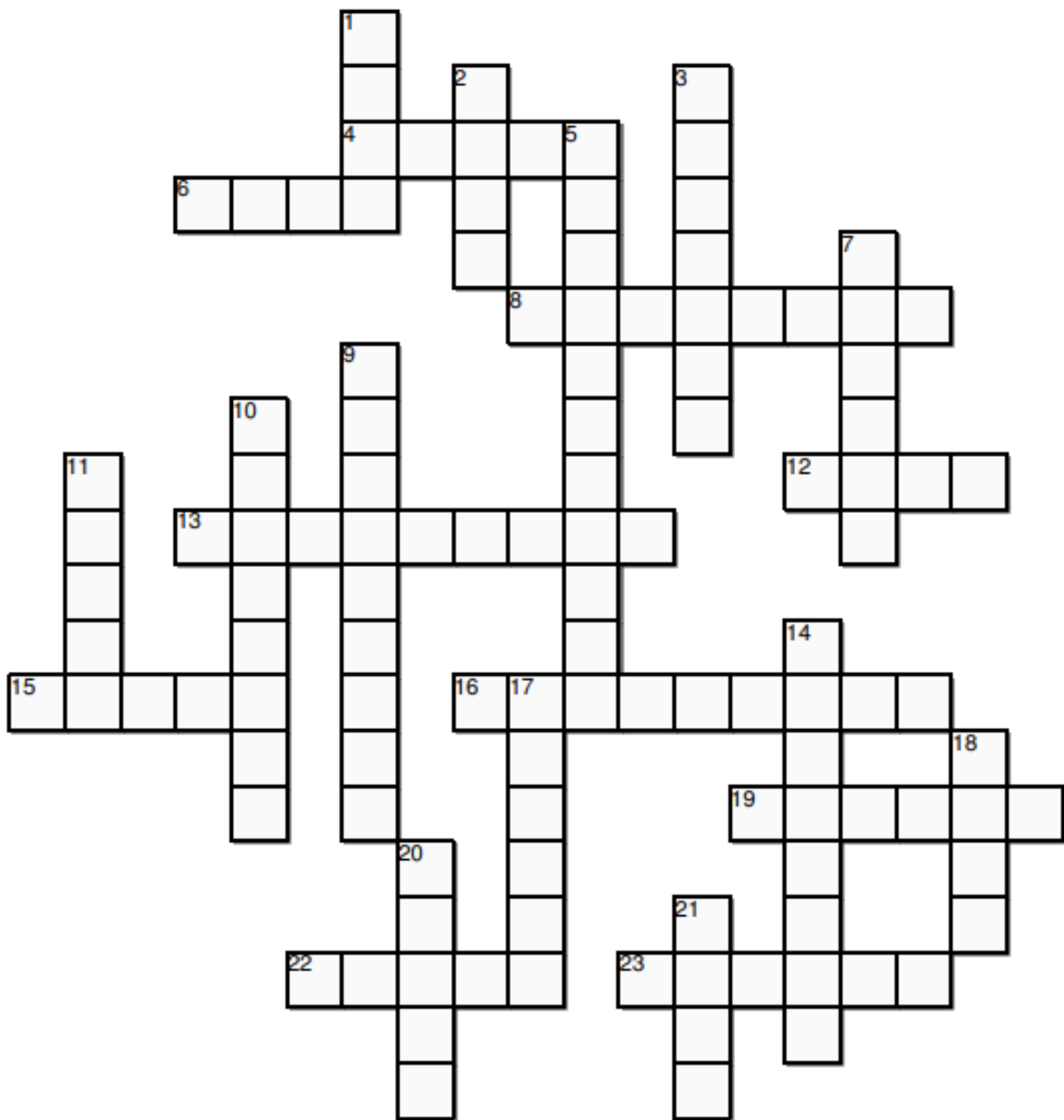
He was brilliant, talented, admired.
