



CALLED TO REST

LABOR DAY ALWAYS SNEAKS UP ON US. IT FALLS RIGHT AFTER THE RUSH OF BACK TO SCHOOL OR FOOTBALL SEASON – IT TRADITIONALLY MEANS THE END OF SUMMER. BUT IT'S A NICE TREAT RIGHT BEFORE YOU HEAD INTO THE FULL CHAOS OF THE FALL SEASON.

THE GIFT OF A DAY OFF ISN'T SOMETHING GOD FORGOT. WHEN HE TOOK SIX DAYS TO CREATE THE WORLD, EVEN HE CHOSE TO STOP AND REST FOR THE SEVENTH DAY.

"THUS THE HEAVENS AND THE EARTH WERE FINISHED, AND ALL THE HOST OF THEM. AND ON THE SEVENTH DAY GOD ENDED HIS WORK WHICH HE HAD MADE; AND HE RESTED ON THE SEVENTH DAY FROM ALL HIS WORK WHICH HE HAD MADE. AND GOD BLESSED THE SEVENTH DAY, AND SANCTIFIED IT: BECAUSE THAT IN IT HE HAD RESTED FROM ALL HIS WORK WHICH GOD CREATED AND MADE." – GENESIS 2:1-3

SOME OF US MIGHT HONOR THIS BIBLICAL COMMAND BY OBSERVING A SABBATH DAY EACH WEEK. OR DEPENDING ON THE SEASON OF LIFE YOU'RE IN, YOU MIGHT TRY TO FIND JUST A FEW MINUTES EACH DAY AS YOUR OWN SABBATH TO HONOR GOD AND REST IN HIM.

THIS LABOR DAY, REMEMBER THAT GOD COMMANDS US TO WORK UNTO HIM RATHER THAN FOR OTHERS – BUT ALSO THAT WE ARE CALLED TO REST.

"AND WHATSOEVER YE DO, DO IT HEARTILY, AS TO THE LORD, AND NOT UNTO MEN; KNOWING THAT OF THE LORD YE SHALL RECEIVE THE REWARD OF THE INHERITANCE: FOR YE SERVE THE LORD CHRIST." – COLOSSIANS 3:23-24
